

# Quilters Barn

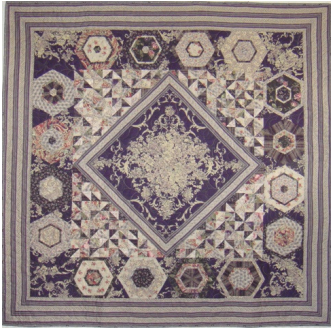
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Greetings from Quilters Barn,

Why is that as soon as the weather starts warming up so does my schedule? Bring on Christmas it will be my quiet time! These two quilts will be in the November issue of Quilters Companion QC 52 as a project and they are using my last range of fabrics called "Angelique". I designed a fabric that could be used as a medallion –on point for the centre of a quilt. The other fabrics are from the Angelique and other fabrics from my previous ranges. This quilt measures 53" (135cm) square but could be the start of a larger quilt. I will have kits available for all the fabric, including binding for \$190 and is available in caramel and dark pink, purple or green. You can also just get the centre panel, border stripes and the Quick patchwork papers for \$105 and you can use up some scraps for the rest.



I have another large quilt called "Appelgebak" which is coming out in November issue of Homespun Vol 12 no 11 and is a great quilt to use up some of the stash. I used the Quick Patchwork Papers so I didn't have to cut out one triangle. They are available up on my website. *Photography courtesy of Homespun magazine.*

**Quilt and Craft Show** in Adelaide Nov 3rd—6th. Stand E30. I will be doing 2 free workshops at each show. One on how to use the Quick Patchwork Papers and the use of colour and fabrics for beginners. The second workshop is Quilt as you go scrap savers, I will show you how to use up those scraps and make great projects using the Quilt as you go technique.



I have made a large Q/S quilt (220cm x 250cm) that I have donated to rotary to raise funds for Rotary International. I will have this quilt at the three shows and will be selling tickets at \$2 each or 6 for \$10. This raffle will also coincide with a quilt exhibition I am putting on for Rotary at the Korumburra Rotary Art Gallery. This runs from Tuesday 29th November to the 11th Dec. 10– 4 and is called "Not quite a lifetime of quilts" and will have quilts ranging from my first quilt to some of the current quilts I have made. There will be quilts I have made for my 3 books and also many for magazine projects, with some of the quilts being for sale. The raffle quilt will be drawn at 3pm Sunday Dec 11th and entry to Quilt exhibition is by a gold coin donation.
